Personal computer games

Can you show me a person who has never tried to play any of computer games? But not everybody knows that the history of them has (1) since at least the 1960s. PC games are usually created by game developers, often in conjunction with other (2) such as game artists. Although PC games have been a source of controversy, particularly related to the violence as well as game (3), the popularity of them do not decrease.

Spacewar! developed in 1961 is often credited as being the first ever computer game. The game (4) of the two player-controlled spaceships maneuvering around a central star, each attempting to (5) the other. The first generation of PC games were often interactive fiction, in which the player communicated with the computer by entering (6) through a keyboard. Increasing adoption of the computer (7) allowed the industry to include increasingly high-quality graphical interfaces.

Further improvements to game artwork became (8) with the introduction of the first sound cards which allowed IBM PC compatible computers to produce complex sounds. The 1993 release of *Doom* on the PC was a breakthrough in 3D graphics and soon ported to various game consoles in a general shift toward greater (9)

With the increased popularity of the Internet, online distribution of games has become more common. Online (10) games have achieved popularity largely as a result of increasing broadband adoption among consumers.

Like other forms of media, computer and video games have been the subject of (11)criticism, due to the depiction of graphic violence. Software piracy is a serious crime.
